7.1.5.1. Restricted Entry of Automobiles


The college serves entry through two adjacent gates, small gate and large gate for permitted, authorised car & heavy motor vehicles. The entry is always monitored in 24 X 7 manner by securities and CCTV surveillance system.

Restricted entry for heavy vehicles is indicated by the notice at the gate.








The college has placed 'Restricted entry' notices at every one kilometre radius.

7.1.5.2. Use of bicycles / battery powered vehicles


Our students the eco-friendly vehicle - bicycle. Rest of the students uses city buses.






Bicycle parking area of the college


Pathway towards Commerce, English, Economics Blocks.




Pathway at MCA Block & Chemistry lab




Pathway at Ground and sports room





Pathway towards College office, Principal's Room and Controllers' office



Pathway at Play Ground








The College Campus extending on both sides of bridge.
